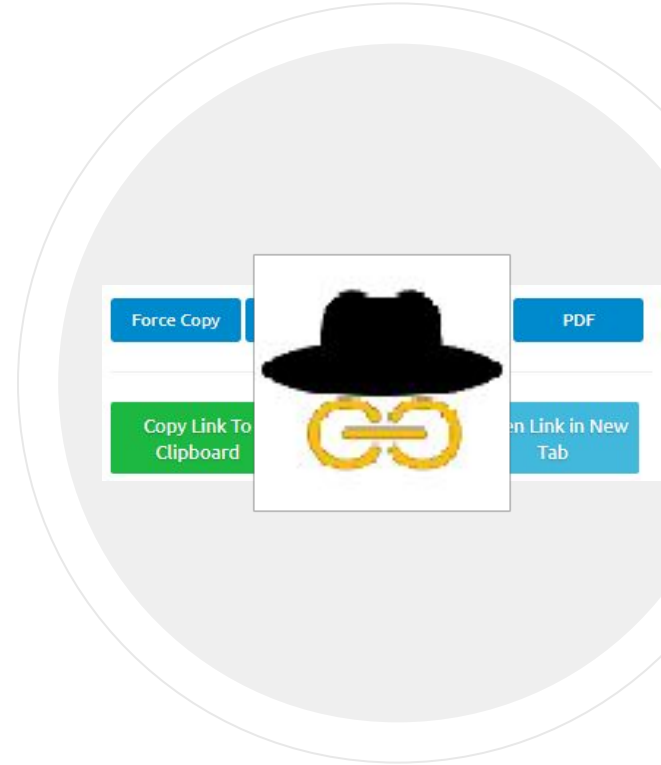

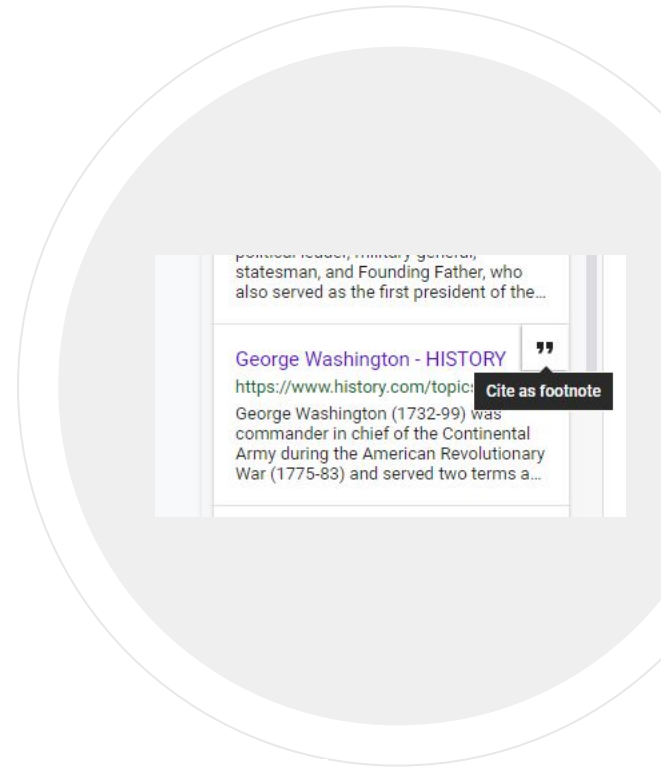

Save as PDF

Saves any website as a PDF

Removes ads and links

Makes online information available offline.



Save to Google Drive

Saves any website as a PNG

Ads are visible but videos and links don't work.

Makes online information available offline.



SafeYouTube.net

Removes all sidebars, adds, and comments from YouTube videos.

Links are easily shareable and work in Google Classroom.

Students have nothing to click on to get out of the content.

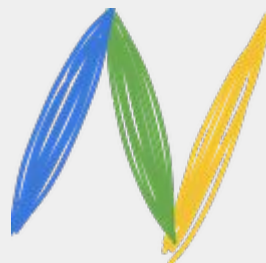
