Step 3: Click Guided Access



Step 4: Turn on Guided Access.



Step 5: Click set Passcode. Make sure you remember this code. Make it simple. 0000 or 1234, just in case you forget to turn it off.



Step 6: Find your app. For this tutorial, we will open AR.



Step 7: Tap the home button quickly three times. This triggers Guided Access within the app. Click Start.



A message will appear saying, "Guided Access has started."



Step 8: Triple-click the home button to exit the app. Enter in the Passcode.

Step 9: Be nice and turn off Guided Access before lending to someone else.
