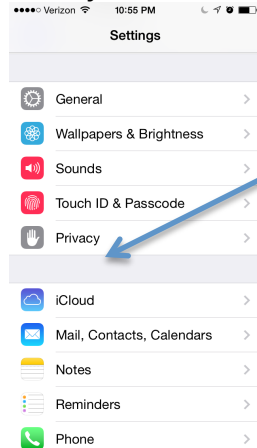


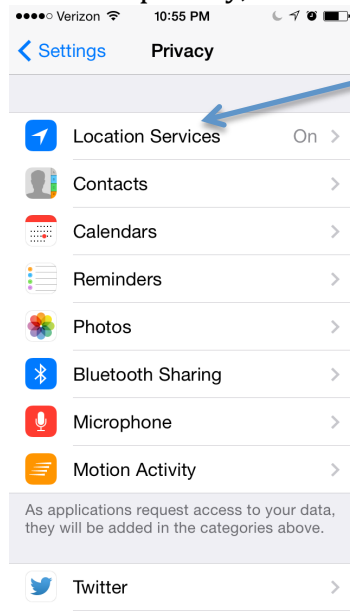
Quickly locate a misplaced iPhone, iPad, or iPod with Find my iPhone

Before you ever get in a situation where you need the “Find my iPhone” feature, ensure that your iOS devices have the feature enabled.

1. Go to your iOS device's settings. Click on “Privacy”.



2. Under privacy, click on “Location Services”.



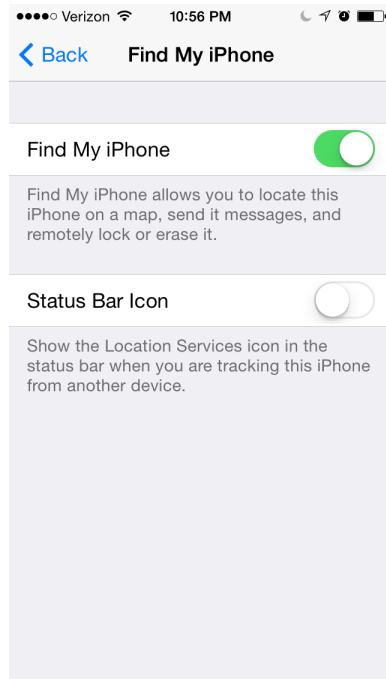
3. Under Location Services, click on “Find My iPhone”.



- ↗ A purple location services icon will appear next to an item that has recently used your location.
- ↗ A gray location services icon will appear next to an item that has used your location within the last 24 hours.
- ↗ An outlined location services icon will appear next to an item that is using a geofence.

A geofence is a virtual perimeter around a location. Apps like Reminders use geofencing to notify you when you arrive at, or leave, these locations.

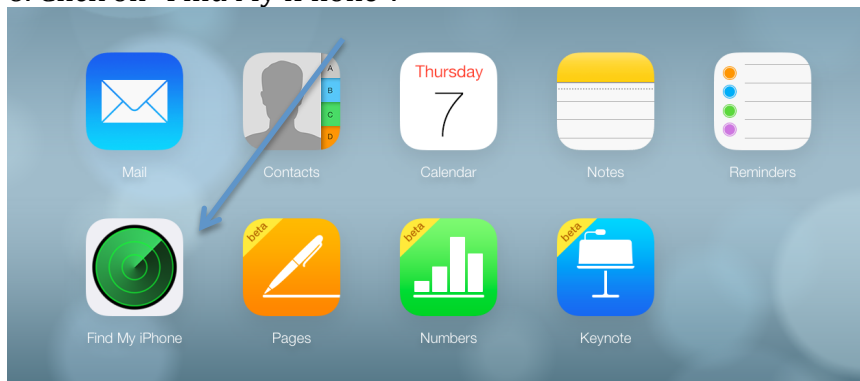
4. Slide the “Find My iPhone” slider to on. Now you can track your iPhone’s location.



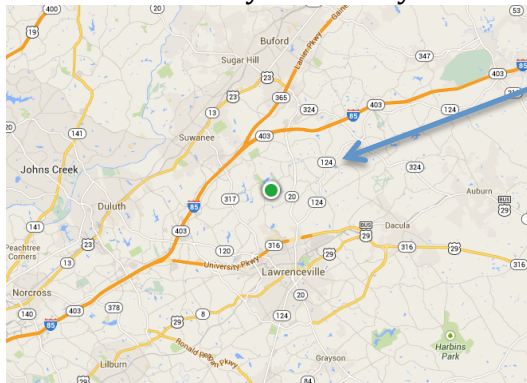
5. In order to see your iPhone's location, you will need go to another device, desktop, or laptop and open up iCloud. Go to www.icloud.com . sign in with the Apple ID and password associated with the device you are tracking.



6. Click on “Find My iPhone”.



7. That will show you where your device is on a map.

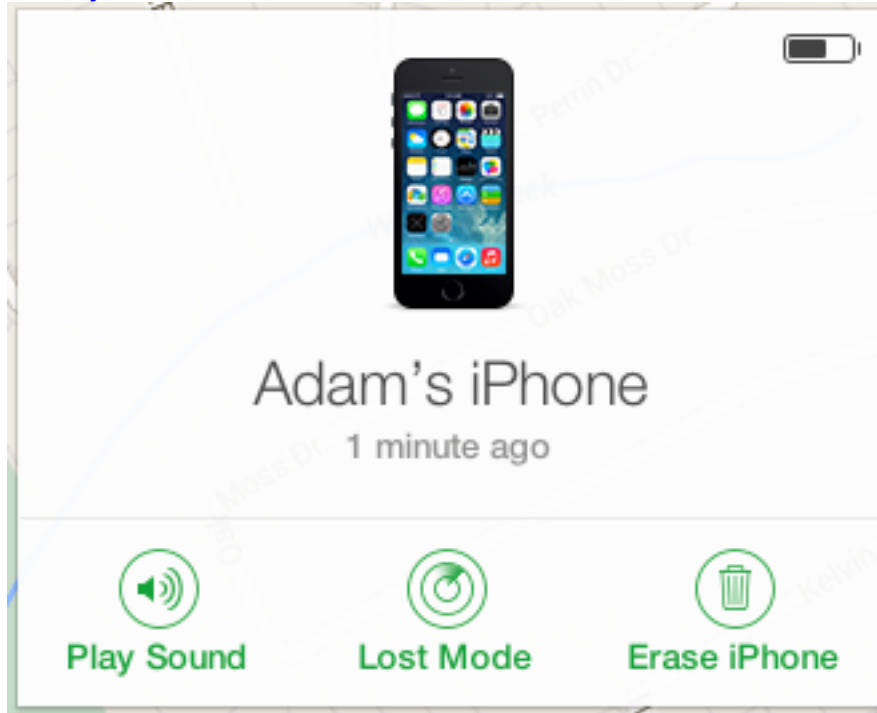


8. You will have a few options for what to do next. Clicking on the green dot will bring up this screen.
