

# Socrative in the Classroom

[All Levels] Rocket Fuel for Assessments. Learn how to instantly connect with your students as learning happens. Create, assign and score quizzes for immediate feedback.

- Create a free Socrative account by following the steps at [socrative.com](http://socrative.com); Get an Account.
- Once you have an account, you can create quizzes by going to “Quizzes” and “Add Test”
- You will have two options to choose from, “Create New” or “Import”
- “Create New”- There is an SOC number automatically generated for each test. It is located at the top right. This can be used to share this test with other Socrative users.
  - Give your test a title and be sure the “enable sharing” is on.
  - Decide of the format for your questions. (multiple choice, true false, or short answer)
  - You test can use a variety of test questions.
  - Be sure to indicate the correct answer by marking the box to the right. (You can have more than one correct answer for each question.)
  - If you would like, you can add an explanation at the bottom of each question. This is optional, and the student sees the explanation if they get the question incorrect.
  - If you would like to align your test to Standards, check that box, and follow the steps indicated.
  - If you click on the “formatting” button, you will have more options while typing. (ex. exponents for math)
  - You can also edit, change the order of the questions, and insert pictures that you have saved on your computer.
  - Make sure you write down your SOC number, and you can click “Save and Exit”.
- “Import” a quiz
  - This is the easiest way to use Socrative.
  - Get a code from another teacher who has already created a Socrative test and enter the code under “import”.
- Once you have a test created, there are several options available.
  - Take a Test
    - Click launch and choose a test you have saved.
    - Click “next” at the bottom
    - Decide on the pace and feedback desired
    - Click “Start”
  - Students need to enter your “Room Code” at [socrative.com](http://socrative.com).
    - This is a randomly assigned number, but you can customize your account name by going to the “Room” tab at the top.
  - Space Race
    - very similar to Quizlet Live
  - Exit Ticket
    - You can ask a quick question without having to generate an entire test.
- “Results”
  - While your students are testing, you can view their progress, see their current score, look at individual questions, and project questions for whole group discussions
  - When the class is finished, you can save the results and/or email them to yourself.
