

## Video Texting with Glide

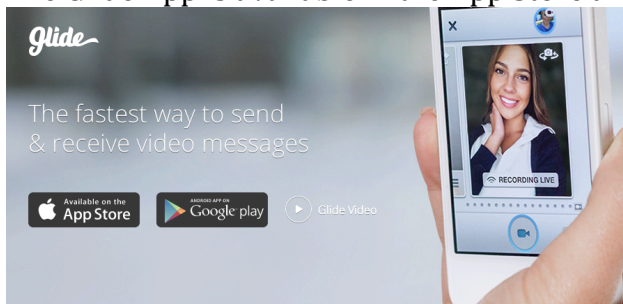
Imagine a mixture of Skype, FaceTime, video texting, video voicemail, and texting all rolled into one. That is what Glide is. Glide bills itself as the “fastest way to send and receive video messages.” This is the cutting edge app of the day. Here is how to get started.

The Glide App is available in the App Store and also the Google Play Store.

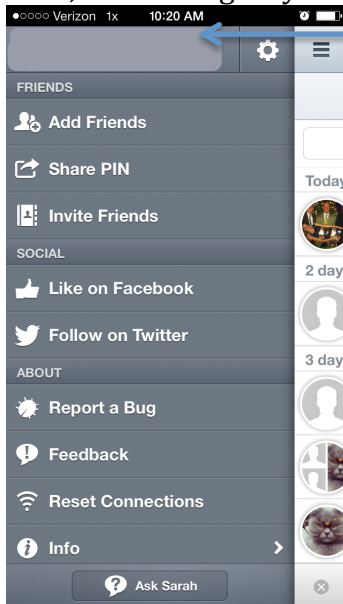

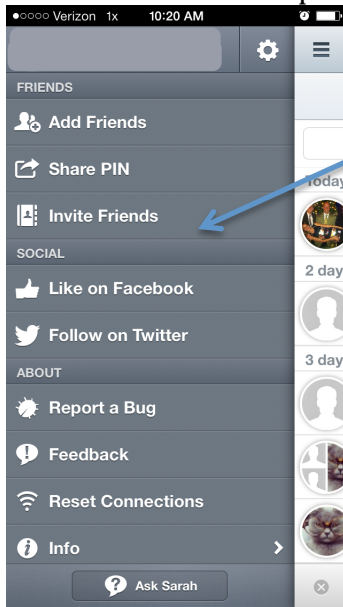

Once you have downloaded the app, then you will create your profile. You will get a choice to sign into your Facebook account. I would recommend against logging into your Facebook account.

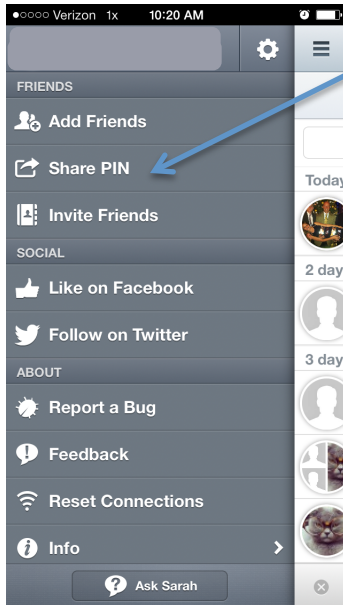
First, Glide will give you a unique pin to share with others. It will be here.



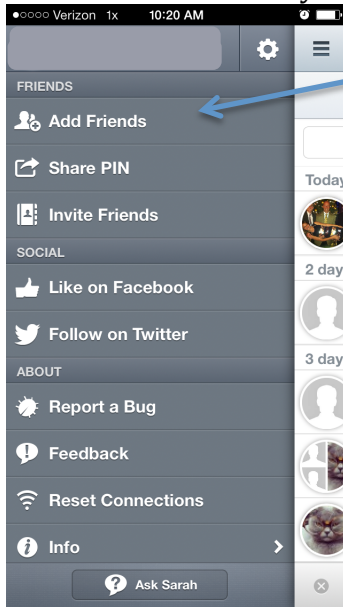
Next, Invite some friends to join and download the app. They will need the app to communicate with you. The Glide App will either access your phone contacts or Facebook contacts depending on what you select.



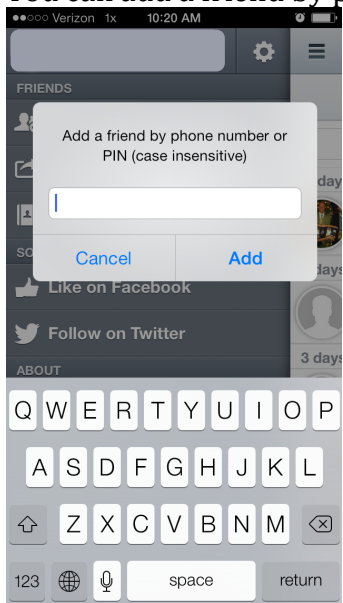
You could also click the “Share PIN” button to link up with your friends and family.



You can add friends by clicking on the “Add Friends” button.



You can add a friend by phone number or PIN (case insensitive).



When you link up with your friends and family, using the app is pretty straightforward. Tap on a person's picture to begin Gliding.

Fun Fact: You can create Glide groups. Communication is not just between two people. Imagine the possibilities!
